Attendance of Children and Babes in Arms

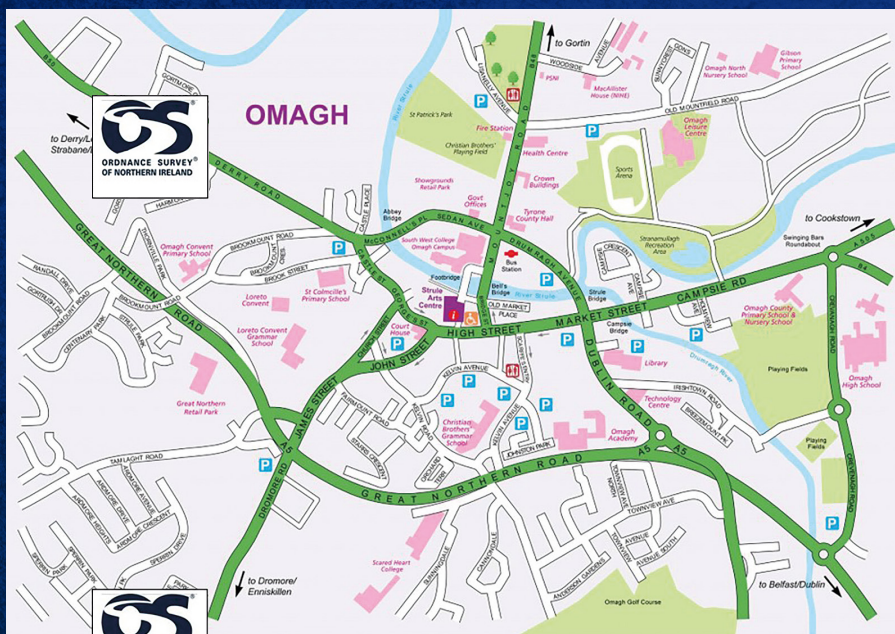
