

Omagh Music Festival 2025: Arty McGlynn – The Master

The 5th Annual Omagh Music Festival takes place from the 7-9 November 2025. This year the focus is on the career of one of the most successful and influential musicians that Omagh has ever produced, the iconic Arty McGlynn [1944 – 2019] guitarist, composer, producer and innovator.

In a career spanning seven decades and multiple genres of music, Arty performed throughout the world with a who's who of musical icons such as Van Morrison, Paul Brady, John Prine, Makem and Clancy, Mary Black, Matt Molloy, Planxty, Liam Og O'Flynn and innumerable others. He was equally at home playing traditional music, blues, jazz, country and rock music. While he was a master of all those styles, with the release of his seminal album 'McGlynn's Fancy' in 1979, he more or less invented a place for acoustic guitar in Irish traditional music.

The Many Sides of Arty McGlynn: The Traditional Legacy

The opportunity to hear Matt Molloy onstage in the hometown of his dear friend and musical collaborator Arty McGlynn is not to be missed. A member of the Bothy Band, Planxty and the Chieftains, for a number of years he and John Carty performed and recorded as a trio with Arty McGlynn.

Arty and Nollaig performed together on many international stages and recorded the influential and critically acclaimed albums 'Lead the Knave' and 'Causeway'. Nollaig will be accompanied by Jerome, who proves that the apple doesn't fall far from the tree in providing a startlingly accurate tribute to his father's artistry. Arty and Nollaig also formed half of the quartet Heartstrings with another genre-defying guitarist Chris Newman and the doyenne of Irish harpers Maire Ni Chathasaigh.

Eamon McElholm formerly of Stockton's Wing and Solas and Shane McAleer formerly of Dervish are highly respected figures in the Irish Traditional music field, nationally and internationally. They often played and exchanged musical ideas - and the occasional pint - with Arty, who was undoubtedly an inspiration to so many younger musicians.

The second concert in this year's Omagh Music Festival will focus on Arty's love of Country, Blues, Rock and Jazz and will feature some of Ireland's most accomplished musicians including local musical legend Brendan Quinn.

Backed by former Van Morrison Band alumni Nicky Scott on bass and Liam Bradley on drums with Rod McVey on keyboards, Brendan gives a particular nod to the 'The Kicking Mule', his joint project with Arty.

The concert will also include performances from the ground-breaking 'Causeway' Album recorded by Arty and Nollaig and will feature Nicky, Liam and Rod, with Nollaig and Cathal Hayden on fiddles and Jerome McGlynn on electric guitar.

Arty relished playing with the anarchic, elemental force which is Mark McCausland, who revisits some of the songs they played together in the company of another astonishing guitar talent, Matt McGlinn.

Attendance of Children and Babes in Arms


