
Important Information

Attendance of Children and Babes in Arms

Concessions

Discounts

When 10 tickets or more are purchased for a show, a 10% discount off the full price can be obtained. For designated evening performances educational groups can obtain a 20% group discount. Only one discount may be applied per booking transaction. Discounts are available by contacting the Box Office.
