Discounts

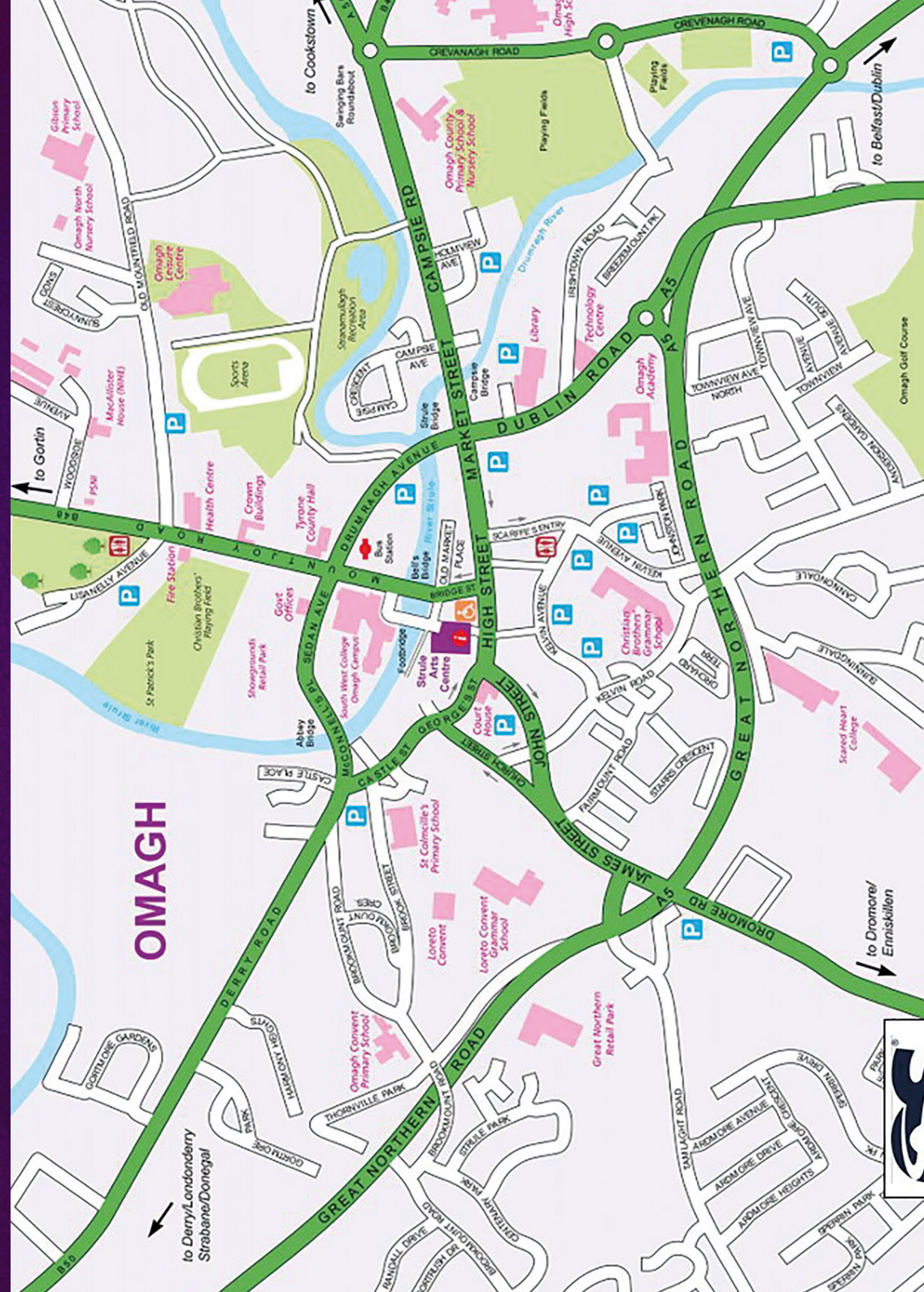
